- Structural Assessment (for demolition only)
- Locus Plan of the Site within the District
- Approval/Consent from Massachusetts Historical Commission, as it relates to (existing) Preservation Restriction Agreement (if applicable)
- Other, as may be determined by the Commission based on project scope

Applicant/Commission shall refer to Town of Northbridge Whitinsville -Downtown Crossroads Historic District Bylaw provision adopted, October 22, 2019 [Fall Annual Town Meeting, Article #7].
